## Recognizing Sergeant John Castiglia

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant John Castiglia has been nominated by the Sacramento Police Department for the 1996 Parade/IACP Police Officer of the Year Award for his exceptional leadership and commitment in the administration of the Criminal Justice Academy Magnet School and the Explorer Post 888 Cadet Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Criminal Justice Academy (the Academy) was established at John F. Kennedy High School in 1990 by the Sacramento Police Department and the Sacramento City Unified School District providing high school students with a four year course of study in law enforcement, stressing academics and placing a strong emphasis on literacy; and

**WHEREAS**, Sgt. Castiglia has served as an instructor since August 1992, was promoted to Sergeant in November 1995, remaining with the program as a school administrator to expand the program in the Sacramento area with the goal of fostering commitment, loyalty, and a contribution to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the city of Sacramento's Criminal Justice Academy has been used as a model by a number of other cities in the United States, and the California State Attorney General's Office has expressed interest in becoming a partner in the program as has the national Communities in Schools Program; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the Academy, Sgt. Castiglia also served as the advisor for the Explorer Post 888 Cadet program, providing law enforcement opportunities to high school and college students; and

**WHEREAS**, Sgt. Castiglia was named the 1996 Teacher of the Year by the Sacramento City Unified School District, received the Certificate of Recognition/Law Enforcement Award from the Carmichael Elks in 1995, and was the first recipient of the Sacramento Regional Foundation's Sally & Hubert Mee award for heroic or meretricious performance in January 1996.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend Sgt. John Castiglia for his commitment and dedication to the youth of the city of Sacramento and do hereby extend best wishes to him for his nomination as 1996 Parade/IACP Police Officer of the Year Award.

**SUBJECT: VARIOUS REQUESTS FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1812 17TH STREET (D4) (CRYSTAL ICE, P93-126) (APN:009-0093-008, 009-0095-001, AND 010)**

**REQUEST:**

**A. Appeal of the Planning Commission Denial of Various Entitlements**

- 1) Major Project Special Permit to construct one 7 story (Building 1) and one 5 story (Building 2) office building totaling 420,000 square feet.
- 2) Special Permit to exceed the 45 foot height limit of the C-2 zone to 97.5 feet for Building 1 and 70.5 feet for Building 2.
- 3) Special Permit for a 40% parking reduction for the 420,000 square foot office building.
- 4) Variance to reduce the front yard setbacks from 15 feet to 0 feet.
- 5) Variance to reduce the side yard setbacks from 5 feet to 0 feet.
- 6) Variance to allow tandem parking.
- 7) Lot Line Adjustment to merge two parcels into one parcel on the eastern half block of the project.

**B. Entitlements to construct one seven story and one five story office building, totalling 420,000 square feet (known as the Crystal Ice project)**
