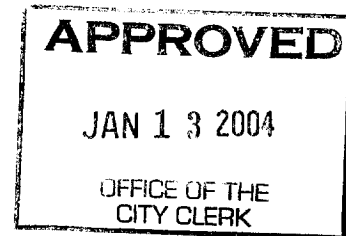

**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME LIMITS ON A PORTION OF FLORIN ROAD**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Florin Road, south side, from Luther Drive east for 200 feet. Council District 8.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to establish a two-hour parking time limit on a portion of Florin Road.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends establishing a two-hour parking time limit on Florin Road from Luther Drive east for 200 feet. (Attachment A). Regulating the parking on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by students from Luther Burbank High School and employees of nearby businesses and provide short-term customer parking. It is estimated that it will cost \$500 to install regulatory signs.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Parking along the south side of Florin Road east of Luther Drive is unregulated.
- Luther Burbank High School students and Florin Road Toyota/Kia employees are using all of the available street parking.
- The Florin Road Toyota/Kia Vice President has requested that this area be regulated with a two-hour parking time limit. This would prohibit all day student and employee parking while providing needed short-term customer parking.
- No other businesses will be impacted.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulations is estimated to be \$500 for the installation of the regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Planning and Building Department, Environmental Services Division has reviewed the recommendation to establish parking time limits on Florin Road and has determined that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Section 15301(c) and Class 11, Section 15311(a) of the CEQA guidelines. Projects exempted under Class 1, Section 15301(c), consist of the operation, repair or minor alterations of existing highways, streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails and similar facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use. Projects exempted under Class 11, Section 15311(a), consist of the construction or replacement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial or institutional facilities, including but not limited to on-premise signs.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This recommendation is consistent with the City's Strategic Plan and the goal of the City Council to enhance and preserve the neighborhoods.

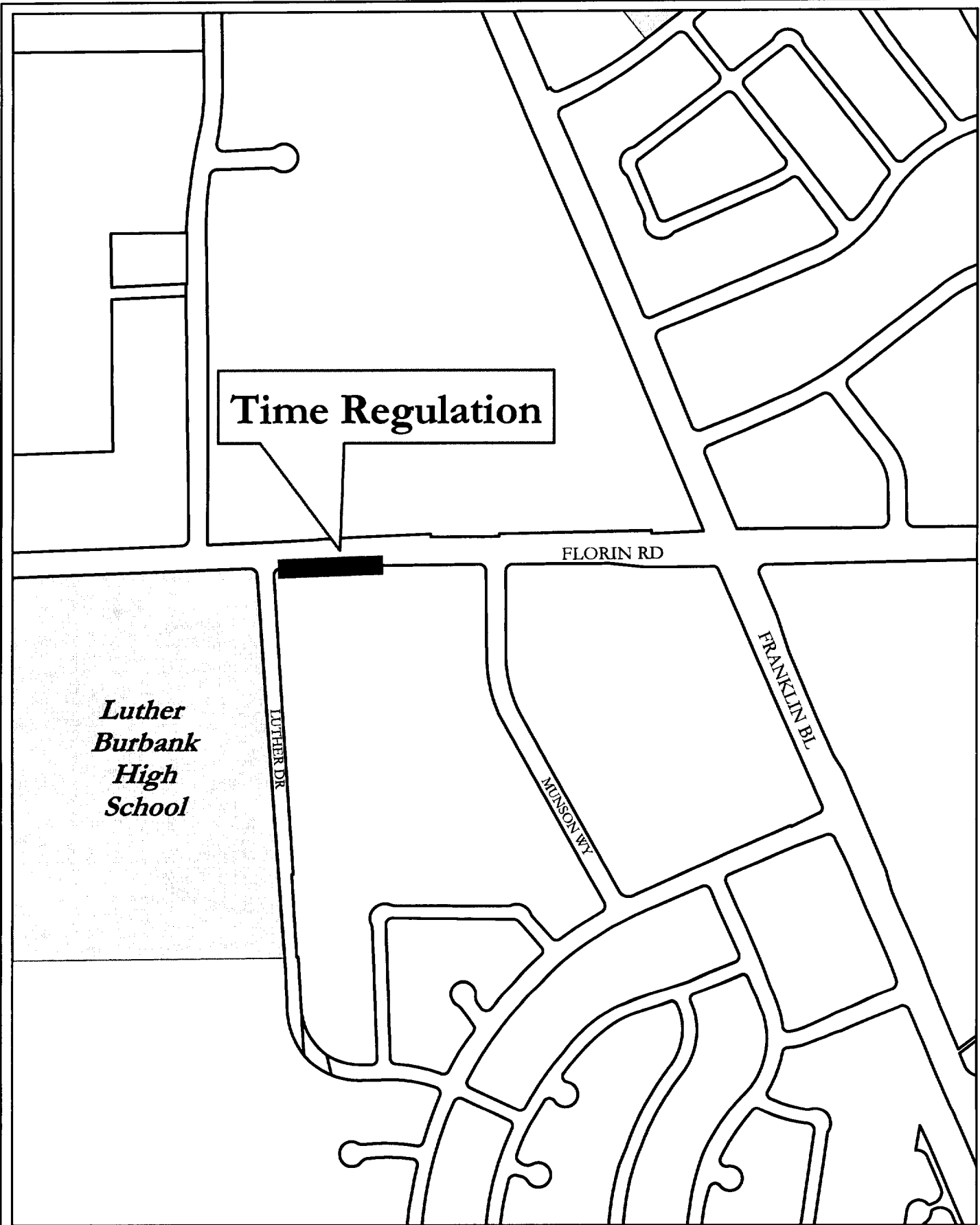

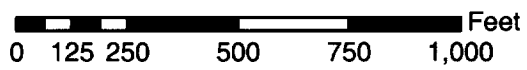

**RESOLUTION NO. 2004-015**

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME LIMITS  
ON A PORTION OF FLORIN ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 10.36.190 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed by the Parking Manager giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle in a business district or on street designated by resolution during the days and hours indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

Parking on the following street segment shall be regulated with two-hour parking from 8 am to 6 pm.

- Florin Road, south side, from Luther Drive east for 200 feet.
