It is hereby noted that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Betty Burpo on January 17, 1981, at the age of 62 years, in the City of Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Mrs. Burpo was well known for her efforts in planting of redwoods, and for her work in creating Jonas Larkspur Park, a grove of redwoods was planted there; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Burpo is survived by her husband James O., who has operated a Sacramento insurance business since 1952, and their children Leslie E. and Jaime E.; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Burpo had been a resident of Sacramento for 32 years and was active in numerous civic and cultural organizations, including the League of Women Voters, Sacramento Symphony Association, Crocker Art Gallery Association, Kingsley Art Club, Sacramento People-to-People, American Field Services, Junior Music Sponsors, Sacramento State University Affiliates, Sacramento Planning and Research Council, KVIE Support Groups and her neighborhood association; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Burpo was a very warm and concerned person, as evidenced by her long list of community activities, and served as an inspiration to her many friends and associates;

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City record the passing of Mrs. Burpo and has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which this meeting shall be called adjourned in respect to the memory of Betty Burpo;
