

ORDINANCE NO. 417 , FOURTH SERIES.


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO CONSTRUCT A RECREATION SHELTER AT JAMES McCLATCHY PARK WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: The proper authorities of the City of Sacramento are hereby authorized and directed to construct a Recreation Shelter at James McClatchy Park, at an estimated cost of Seven Hundred Forty-One Dollars (\$741.00), in accordance with the plans submitted by the City Manager, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency existing because there is not sufficient time to advertise for bids and award a contract for the construction of said shelter before same is needed for the summer, and it further appearing that no saving can be accomplished in the construction of said shelter, even if bids were asked for.
