SUBJECT: 11th and N Street Sewer Replacement (PN:XB81) - Project
Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

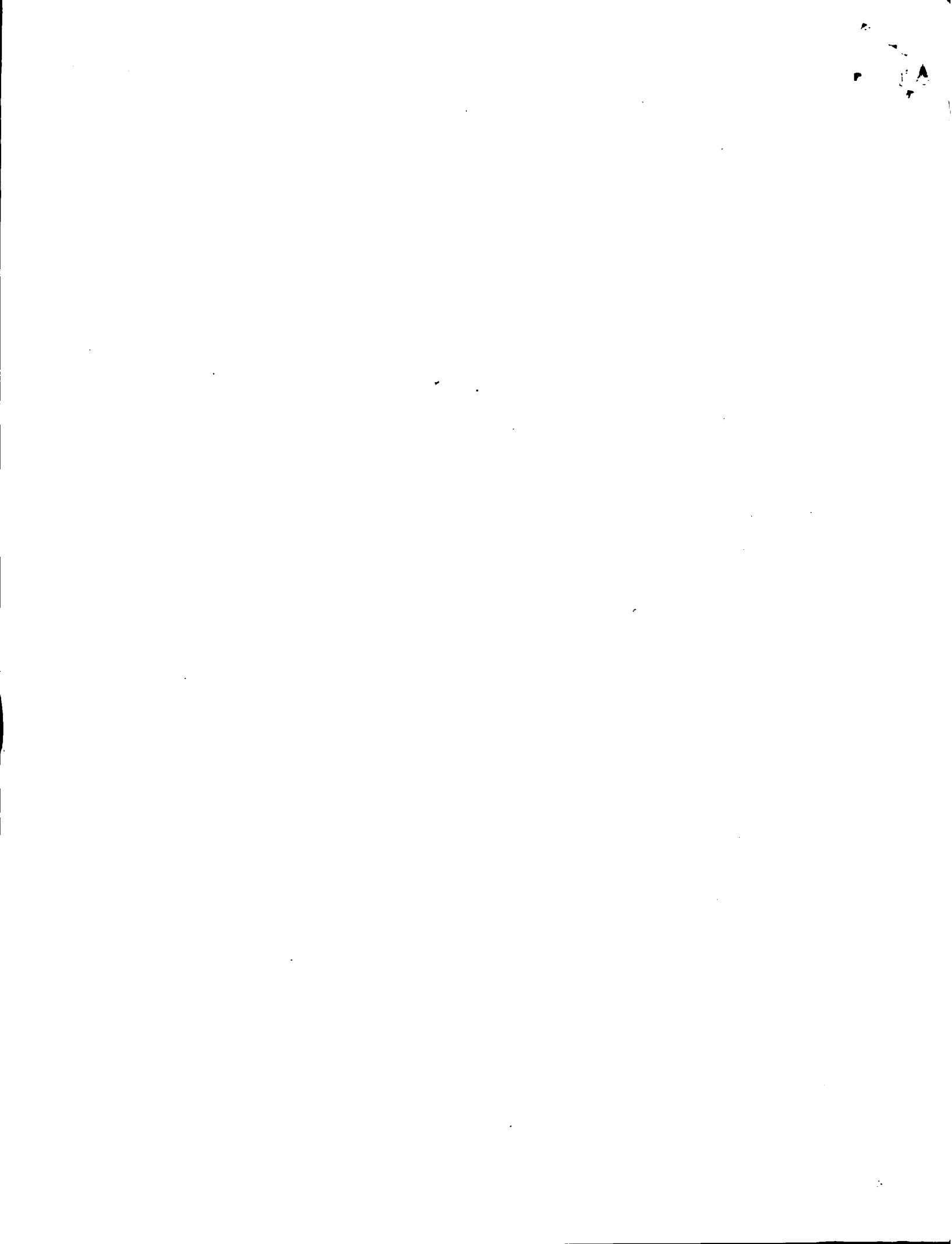
The existing brick sewer along 11th Street between N Street and the N-O Alley is deteriorated and needs to be replaced. This project will replace the brick sewer with polyvinylchloride (PVC) pipe.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on January 18, 1989. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$17,100.

FINANCIAL DATA

Additional funds may be needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$29,500. The current budget is \$28,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the Sewer Fund (414). The funds available for this project amount to \$17,300 as of January 10, 1989. If additional funds will be required, the final budgetary recommendation will be made following receipt of bids.

A non-refundable fee of \$15 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

There are no policy considerations associated with this item.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on February 21, 1989.
