SUBJECT: Metro Arts Division - Authorization to Submit Grant Application
under the C.A.C.'s 1982-83 Organizational Grants Program

SUMMARY

This report recommends authorization for the Metropolitan Arts Division to submit a grant application to the California Arts Council in the amount of \$16,000 (SIXTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS) to continue the Artreach Community Artists Program.

BACKGROUND

Artreach began in 1982 to assist artists in gaining employment in the community and to encourage community institutions and organizations to incorporate arts programming as part of their regular schedules.

Artists interested in the program apply to S.M.A.C. to provide a specific artistic service geared for a particular institution or audience. These services might include a lecture/demonstration, workshop, and/or performance. Applicants are screened by a panel of arts professionals and community representatives and those selected are included in the Artreach Artists Directory with a description of the specific activity. The program does not limit the number of artists included in the Directory.

This grant application requests funding for artists' fees and partial salary support for the Artreach Coordinator.

FINANCIAL DATA

This grant does not require additional City or County funds. However, a 50/50 match is required in funds other than state monies. The Metro Arts Division intends to match the grant amount through corporate support.




