

ORDINANCE NO. 1545, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBDIVISION (a) RELATING TO TAXI METER RATES OF SECTION 21 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1318, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 26, 1947, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF TAXICABS, AUTOMOBILES AND PUBLIC VEHICLES FOR HIRE, FIXING THE RATE TO BE CHARGED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS AND PERSONAL BAGGAGE, AND THE LICENSE FOR SOLICITING SUCH TRANSPORTATION, PROVIDING A PUNISHMENT FOR ANY VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH." THIS ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT AND BE EFFECTIVE ON JANUARY 1, 1951, AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 13 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Subdivision (a) entitled TAXI METER RATES of Section 21 of Ordinance No. 1318, Fourth Series, passed September 26, 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

TAXI METER RATES

(a) For the first 1/3 mile, or fraction thereof, 35 cents. For each additional 1/3 mile, or fraction thereof, 10 cents.

Waiting time to be computed and paid for at the rate of \$3.00 per hour.

No additional charge for additional passengers to same destination.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within ten days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento. Said ordinance to take effect January 1, 1951, pursuant to Section 13 of the City Charter, being one fixing a public rate, namely, taxi fares, within the City of Sacramento.


