SUBJECT: Amendment No. 2 to Consultant and Professional Services Agreement
No. 87338 with Sacramento Local Conservation Corps

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City Manager be authorized to approve Amendment No. 2 to the Consultant and Professional Services Agreement No 87338 with Sacramento Local Conservation Corps for an amount not to exceed \$30,000 for alley cleanup and other right-of-way maintenance work in various locations of the City.

BACKGROUND

On March 1, 1988 the City entered into an agreement with Sacramento Local Conservation Corps (SLCC) to provide personnel to clean various alleyways and provide other right-of-way maintenance work in various locations of the City. The SLCC provides a crew or crews, as necessary, of 8 to 10 personnel to clean alleys of brush, weeds, tree limbs, debris, and to perform other routine maintenance as agreed upon. The SLCC hauls all debris to the City's designated landfill site and the City waives all dumping fees for the SLCC project performed for the City. This program provides education, job training, and employment for 18-23 year-old unemployed youths from the community.

This agreement was for an amount not to exceed \$19,900. This amount covered the work done from March through June (remainder of the 1987/88 fiscal year). Amendment No. 1 requested an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for a full fiscal year of work. During fiscal year 90/91 operating budget hearings, the Department of Public Works committed to an additional \$30,000 for the contract.

This past summer and fall the City used the SLCC extensively for weed abatement and alley cleaning. Funds for this year's contract are nearly depleted. There are still several work projects needing attention this spring.

FINANCIAL DATA

The funding for this amendment to the consultant and professional services agreement is available in the 1990/91 Street Division operating budget.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Section 58.6 of the Sacramento Municipal Code regarding professional service agreements.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Amendment No. 2 to the agreement with Sacramento Local Conservation Corps (Consultant and Professional Services Agreement No. 87338) for an amount not to exceed \$30,000 be approved by passage of the attached resolution.
