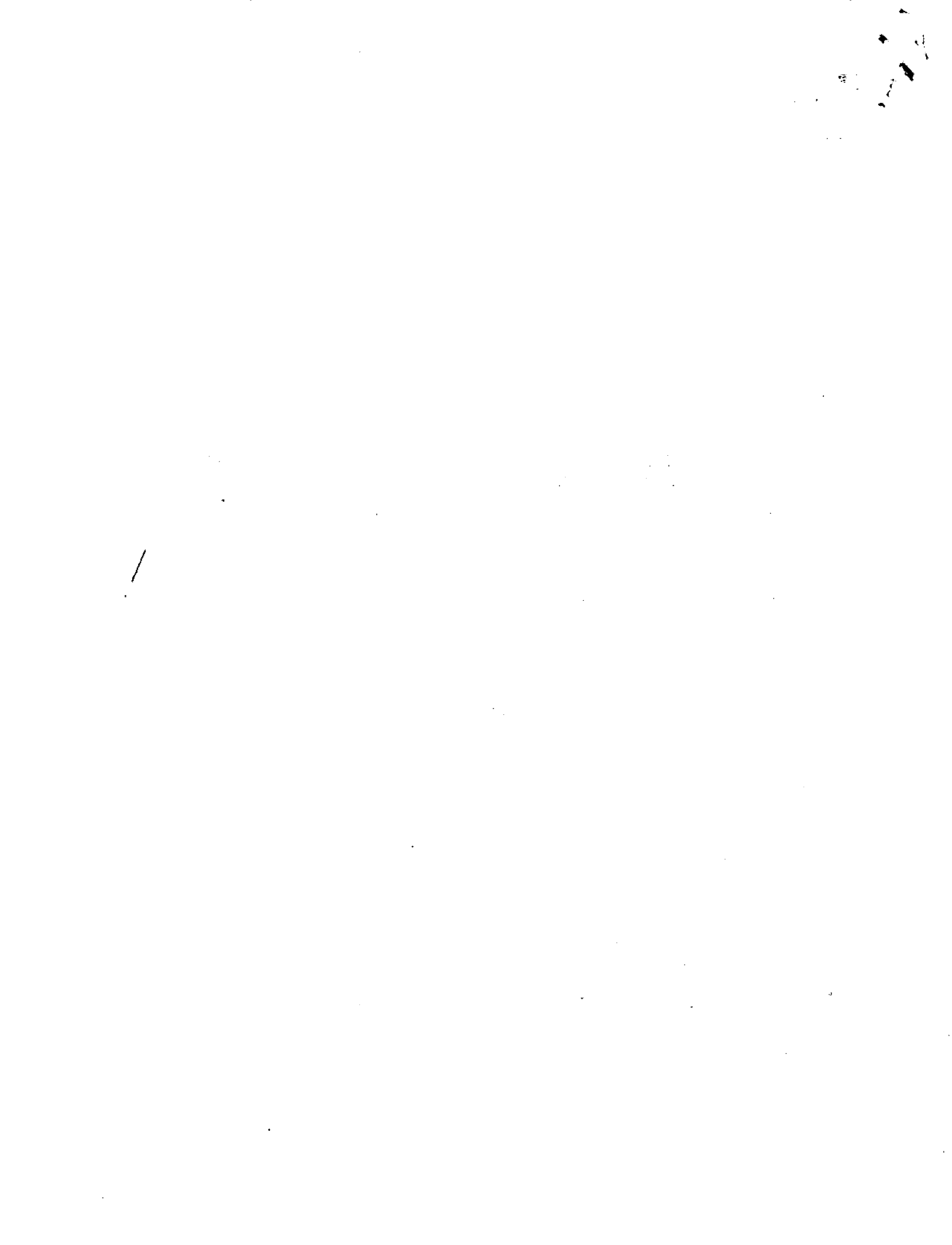

SUBJECT: Resolution Approving Consultant Agreement for Design of Improvements  
to Sump No. 22 and Outfall Channel

SUMMARY:

It is recommended that the attached agreement with Raymond Vail and Associates for the design of improvements to drainage Sump No. 22 and outfall channel be approved, and that \$24,000 in Drainage Bond Funds be transferred from Cost Center 1817, Miscellaneous Drainage Facilities, to the subject project.

BACKGROUND:

The area south of Florin Road between 21st Street and Tamoshanter Way currently floods under conditions of moderate to heavy rainfall, and does not recede for prolonged periods of time. A study prepared for the City by Raymond Vail and Associates recommends that the most economical solution for providing relief to the subject area is to increase the pumping capacity of Sump 22 which is the drainage outlet for the subject area. It is also recommended that the capacity of the outfall channel which runs through Bing Maloney Golf Course be improved to accommodate the increased flows.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The 1982/83 budget includes \$250,000 in Drainage Bond Funds for miscellaneous projects. As of December 3, 1982, the unappropriated balance is \$105,000. It is recommended that \$24,000 be transferred to the subject project so that Engineering plans can be completed. It is estimated that construction costs will be approximately \$185,000. A recommendation for funding will be made after plans are completed.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend to the full City Council that \$24,000 in Drainage Bond Funds be transferred from Cost Center 1817, Miscellaneous Drainage Facilities, to the subject project, and the attached agreement with Raymond Vail and Associates in the amount of \$21,800 be approved by passage of the attached Resolution.
