SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Temporary Street Closure, Old Sacramento,
July 3rd Celebration

SUMMARY

The street closure proposed is necessary for the safety of the citizens of our City who will be attending the July 3rd Celebration in Old Sacramento.

BACKGROUND

With the planned activities scheduled for this celebration, we anticipate that a crowd of 50,000 people will be attending. With this number of people confined in this small geographical area, the circulation of through traffic would be extremely dangerous. This coincides with the Jazz Festival held in Old Sacramento, Memorial Day Weekend, a similar resolution was approved by the City Council.

It is recommended that the City Council approve this resolution for the safety of the citizens attending this event.

RESOLUTION APPROVING PERMIT IN OLD SACRAMENTO
FOR TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE SUBJECT TO RULES
AND REGULATIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Vehicle Code Section 21101 of the State of California, and after consideration of this subject, the City Council hereby declares that certain streets and alleys in the old Sacramento area shall be closed to motor vehicles from July 3, 1980 at 4:00 p.m. to July 4, 1980 at 3:00 a.m. as shown on the map designated Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. Access to streets in the Old Sacramento area shall be permitted only for vehicles utilizing the parking lots designated in Exhibit "A".

2. That the permit for temporary street closure is hereby issued to the Old Sacramento Citizen Merchant Association, subject to the rules and regulations contained in the permit marked Exhibit "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. That the City Council, because of the large crowd expected to attend the July 3rd Celebration, declares that this street closing is necessary for the safety and protection of persons who are to use said streets during the temporary closing.

4. That the City Manager shall be responsible for taking all necessary action to implement the provisions of this resolution.

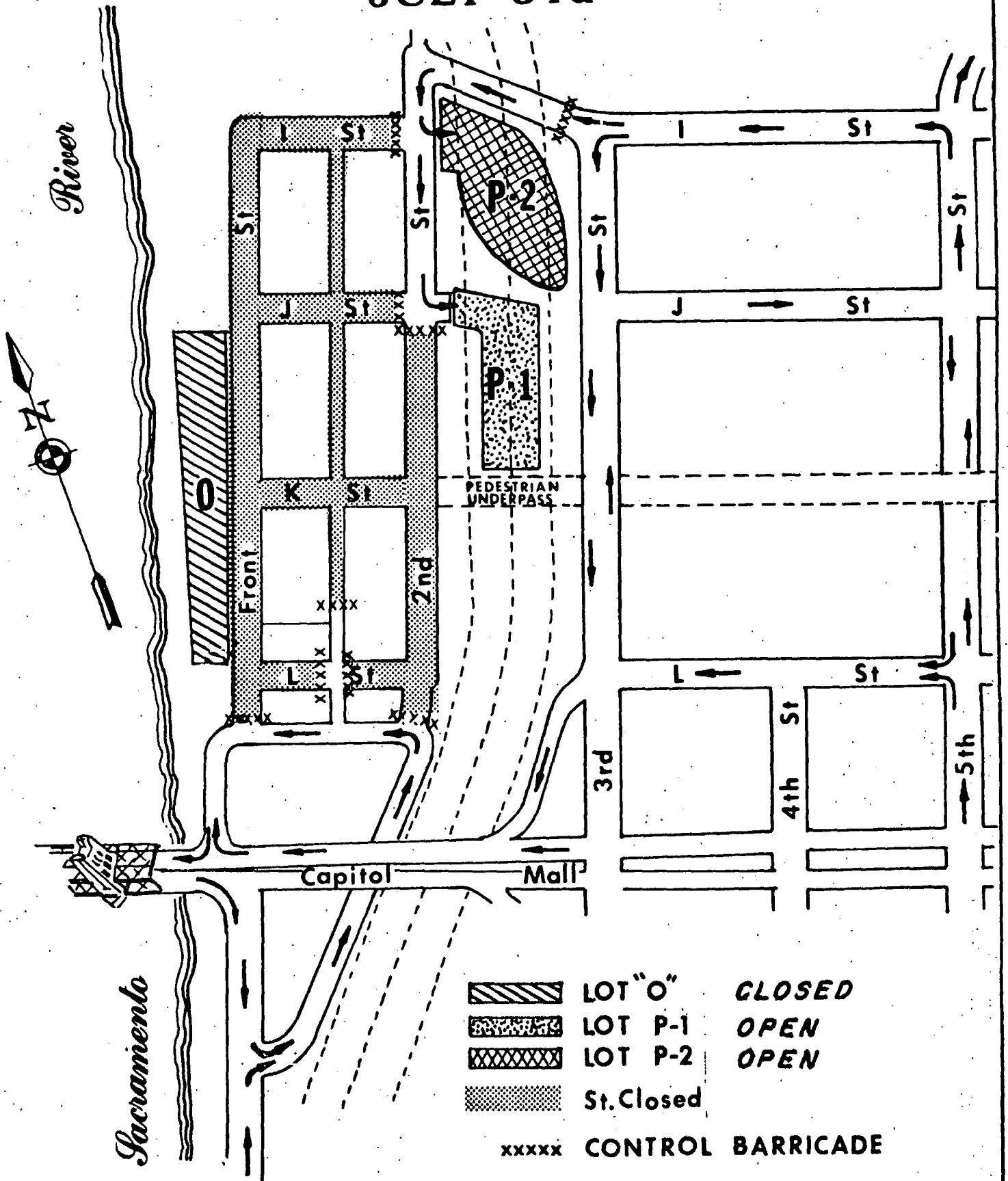
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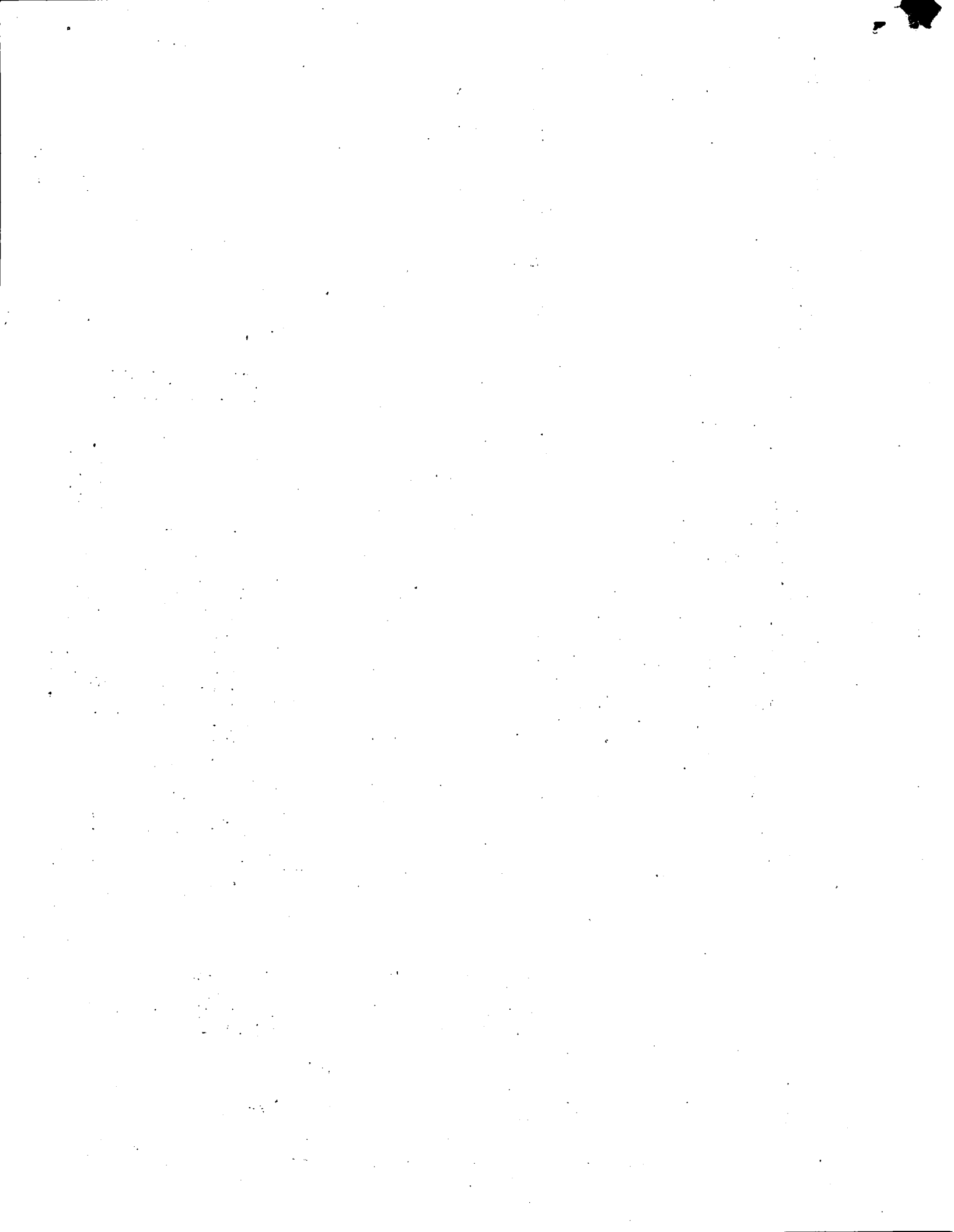

1. A \$5 non-refundable processing fee is required.
2. Barricades shall be used to close the street to through traffic, and are available from the Traffic Engineering Division. Arrange for the pickup and return of barricades by telephoning the Corporation Yard 449-5463 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:30 P.M. at least 24 hours before pickup. A \$20 Deposit is required at the time the barricades are picked up and will be refunded if the barricades are returned within five days in good condition. The value of any damage done to the barricades will be evaluated by the Traffic Control Supervisor and deducted when the barricades are returned.
3. The applicant shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Sacramento, its officers, employees and agents harmless from any cost, expense or liability arising out of the granting of this permit, the use of the streets pursuant hereto and any activity conducted by the applicant.
4. All debris and trash must be removed from streets immediately after the activity or event.
5. It is illegal to sell alcoholic beverages without a permit from the Alcoholic Beverage Control, State of California.
6. This permit authorizes only the erection of barricades for the purpose of closing the street indicated above. This permit does not authorize any activity otherwise prohibited by law and shall not constitute any exception or excuse for violation of any law, ordinance or regulation.

7. This permit is approved subject to the condition that, prior to the street closure, the applicant file with the Department of Finance of the City of Sacramento a Certificate of Insurance showing the applicant has in full force and effect a policy or policies of insurance issued by an insurer or insurers approved by the Director of Finance with the following limits:

\$1,000,000 Single Limit

(If no insurance required, check here: _____).

Said Certificate of Insurance shall indicate City of Sacramento as an additional insured on said policies. The deposit of said Certificate shall not excuse or be a substitute for compliance with paragraph 3 above.
