SUBJECT: Sump 86 Elimination and Bypass - Fund Transfer and Contract Award (PN:XC01)

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

Sewer Sump 86, which is located near Fairfield Street and Acacia Avenue has deteriorated to the point that it is no longer effective. This project will eliminate the sump and replace it with a gravity flow system leading to the county interceptor. The project was designed by the Flood Control and Sewer Division.

On June 20, 1989, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on July 18, 1989. The bids received were:

Daniel Ontiveros Construction Co.	\$125,000
Dorfman Construction Co., Inc.	\$159,910

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$118,000. The estimated project completion date is March 1, 1990.

FINANCIAL DATA

Additional funds are needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$141,000. The current budget is \$125,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Sewer Funds (414). The needed \$16,000 will be transferred from the project for Miscellaneous Sewer Improvements (414-500-XB16-4414). As of July 25, 1989, the funds currently available in the Miscellaneous Sewer Improvements Project is \$25,000 from Sewer Funds (414) and \$80,000 from Storm Drainage Funds (425).

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POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

None.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry in Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE\WBE contractors. There were six (6) planholders for this project, only one of whom is a certified MBE contractor, who submitted a bid and is the low bidder.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of Daniel Ontiveros Construction Co. in the amount of \$125,000, and award the contract.


