ALBERT LAZZARINI  
Civil Service Status

A letter from A. J. Lazzarini, dated November 9, 1944, requesting clarification of his Civil Service status, was presented to the Board. A letter from Carl M. Hoskinson, Superintendent of the Water Department dated November 9, 1944, referring to the work of Mr. Lazzarini, was also presented to the Board. Messrs. Hoskinson and Lazzarini appeared before the Board augmenting the information contained in the above letters and outlining the intermittent character of the work in the Division of Water. After review of the records and discussion by the Board, it was the findings of the Board that Albert Lazzarini had been certified from the Pump Operator Eligible Register #112 and had completed his probationary period prior to the abolishment of the Pump Operator's Eligible Register No. 112 November 4, 1943.
