SUMMARY

The attached resolution authorizes the Executive Director to enter into a one year agreement, March 1, 1988 through February 28, 1989, with the Sierra Foundation for \$29,000 for the "Recovering At Home" component of the SENP's Home Delivered Meal program.

BACKGROUND

Through the "Recovering At Home" program frail elderly persons will recuperate in their homes when discharged from the hospital. Due, in part, to the Diagnostic-Related Group (DRG) System, persons are being released from acute care settings "quicker and sicker," thus requiring greater assistance with Activities of Daily Living (ADL's), meals being of crucial importance. There is no program in this community consistently able to address this issue. The Sacramento Elderly Nutrition-Home Delivered Meal Program currently is serving beyond funding capacity and has a waiting list.

This program will provide 20 meals per day as a set aside for referral by hospital discharge planners from nine local hospitals. Elderly will receive a meal the day after referral and a home visit within three days. Persons will be rotated off the program within a six week period. If extended meals are required they will be placed on the regular Home Delivered Meal program within the six week period when a vacancy is available.

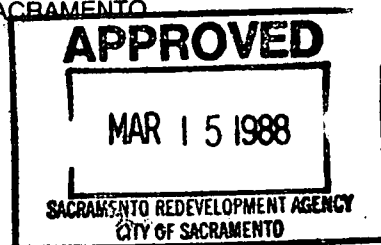

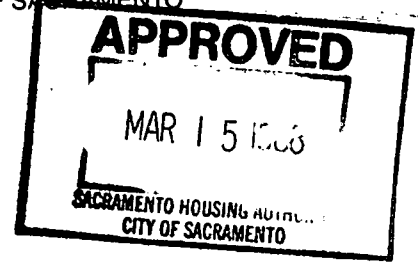
