CLARIFICATION OF APPOINTING AUTHORITY OF ADMINISTRATIVE

ASSISTANT TO THE MAYOR AND EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

#### SUMMARY

The Personnel and Public Employees Committee considered the attached report and voted to recommend to the full Council that the Mayor appoint the Administrative Assistant to the Mayor, and that the Mayor and the Council jointly appoint their Executive Secretary. Resolutions accomplishing this are attached.

#### BACKGROUND

On March 3, the Personnel and Public Employees Committee discussed the appointing authority for positions in the Mayor's and Council's offices. The Committee agreed with the need for a resolution implementing the authority under Section 74 of the Charter for the Mayor to appoint the Administrative Assistant to the Mayor.

The Committee also discussed the options for appointing the Executive Secretary described in the attached report. The Committee decided that the best option was for the Mayor and Council jointly to make the appointment. The Committee would interview candidates either by itself and refer the top one(s) to the Mayor, or, if the Mayor desired, jointly interview with the Mayor.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the following resolutions, which provide that:

1. The Mayor is the appointing authority for the Administrative Assistant to the Mayor.

2. The Mayor and City Council shall jointly appoint their Executive Secretary.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the Mayor and the City Council shall jointly appoint employees in the Mayor's and City Council's Offices to the classification of Executive Secretary.
