

ORDINANCE NO. 660, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A TRUCK IN OPEN MARKET WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market, for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento one (1) Moreland 1930 Model ED6 Five Ton, 6 Wheel, Truck, with enclosed cab and pneumatic tires, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency being the necessity of immediately procuring said truck for the Park Department and a better price on same can be obtained in the open market.
