Subject: CIVIC CENTER PLAZA GARAGE PROJECT (VA66) EXTENSION OF BID PERIOD

### **SUMMARY**

This report recommends that the City Council, by resolution, approve an extension of the bid period for the Civic Center Plaza Garage Project (VA66) to October 2, 1990.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On April 17, 1990, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Civic Center Plaza Garage and authorized the receipt of bids on June 5, 1990.

During the course of plan check consultations among various departments of the City and private engineering professionals, a technical question developed concerning the soils engineering calculations utilized in the design assumptions for the garage structure. Changes in the Uniform Building Code were made following the 1989 Watsonville Earthquake which resulted in higher seismic requirements. On May 22, 1990, the City Council approved a recommended time extension to the previous bid date to July 24, 1990.

The time extension was used for further site testing, including a down hole shear wave velocity study to determine the correct coefficient for earthquake requirements at this specific project site. The results indicated that additional structural changes in the garage design were required. These changes and the City staff's preference to avoid large change orders to the project resulted in the cancellation of the bid opening on July 24, 1990 (see Attachment A).

Revisions to the project plans and specifications will result in two changes to the documents previously advertised. The changes include modifications for seismic safety and the integration of the artwork plans and specifications developed through the City's Art In Public Places Policy.

Final documents for these changes are expected to be completed by September 4, 1990. All current plan holders will be provided with the revisions and a new bid date set for October 2, 1990. Additional contractor interest in the project can be anticipated.

### **POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**

This report is consistent with existing City policies.

## MBE/WBE EFORTS

The initial adoption of the plans and specifications established the MBE/WBE guidelines.

#### **FINANCIAL**

The added costs for the structural upgrade and the artwork are included in the approved project budget of \$24,657,000 which has a construction contingency of \$1,400,000 and a project contingency of \$682,000.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, approve the extension of the bid period for the Civic Center Plaza Garage Project (VA66) to October 2, 1990.
