SUBJECT: Furnishing and Installation of Police and Fire Communications Console, Radio and Related Systems and Equipment (C.C. 2404) - Contract Completion

SUMMARY

Motorola, Inc has completed the above referenced project under Project Number 2404, Council Contract No. C-82060 dated May 16, 1985. This work was completed October 21, 1985 at a cost of \$1,587,659.12 and acceptance is recommended.

BACKGROUND

On April 12, 1983, City Council awarded to Motorola, Inc. the contract for furnishing and installation of Police and Fire communications system at the new Communications Center, providing a centralized dispatch point for the City.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the project be accepted, the Notice of Completion and Acceptance of Work be filed with the County Recorder, and the final payment be authorized.

SUBJECT: 24th Street and 50th Avenue - Signals and Handicapped Ramps
(CC: 1825) - Fund Transfer and Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

On October 1, 1985, the City Council approved plans and specifications for this project and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on October 22, 1985. Bids received are as follows:

Smith Electric Supply	\$124,313.00
May-Han Electric, Inc., dba M & M Electric	\$124,325.00
Challenge Electric	\$136,322.00
Grayson Electric Company	\$137,449.83
Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractor	\$139,645.00
J K Hayes, Inc.	\$155,426.00
Steiny and Company, Inc.	\$171,431.94

The estimated completion date for the project is May 1, 1986.

FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved \$125,000 in the Public Works budget from Major Street Construction funds for this project. The total amount currently available is \$121,000. It is proposed that \$25,000 of Gas Tax funds be transferred from the Miscellaneous Improvements Account (CC: 1258) to cover the cost for this contract. The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$107,000.

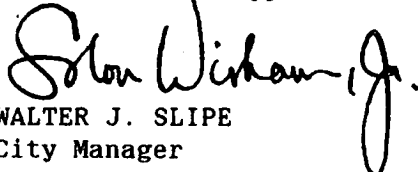
