MINUTES:

Marty Van Duyn, Director of Planning, explained that a vesting tentative map is exempt from subsequent changes in regulations or zoning. The proposed ordinance amendment would bring the City practice into conformance with changes in the State Map Act and is based upon a similar format adopted by Sacramento County in 1986. Mr. Van Duyn stated that he was unaware of any opposition to the proposed changes.

It was MOVED by committee member Ferris and SECONDED by committee member Shore to approve staff recommendation. The vote in favor was unanimous.
