**SUBJECT:** Sacramento Light Rail Double Tracking Project (JN:1972) - Approval of Project Agreement with the Sacramento Regional Transit District

**SUMMARY**

A project agreement has been reached between the Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT) and the City of Sacramento, granting permission to RT for the construction of a second track and related improvements to the Light Rail line located within the City's rights-of-way in the downtown area on 12th and North 12th Streets, and in the north area on Del Paso Boulevard and Arden Way. Approval of the project agreement is recommended.

**BACKGROUND**

The Sacramento Regional Transit District is adding a second track along a portion of line currently served by only one track to improve system reliability, flexibility, and safety. Plans are currently being finalized for the first phase of conversion to double trackage of approximately 7,000 feet in the north corridor from 12th and G Streets to North 12th Street and Richards Boulevard. Construction is expected to begin in September of 1989. Plans for the second phase from the Arden/Del Paso Intersection to the El Camino Avenue overcrossing are being developed with construction to begin in the spring of 1990. The projects include track construction, City street reconstruction, electrical and signal system modifications, station reconstruction and other related modifications. All work will be in conformance with City specifications and requirements.

**FINANCIAL DATA**

This agreement addresses the responsibilities of RT and the City during and after construction of the Double Tracking project. No adjustments to any funds are necessary. All project and maintenance costs are being paid by RT.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**

Regional Transit's program to upgrade system reliability and safety is consistent with the City's Transportation Systems Management (TSM) ordinance which includes encouragement for increased reliance on public transit.


**MBE/WBE EFFORTS**

Not applicable.


**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that City Council approve the project agreement by Adoption of the attached resolution.
