

## **RESOLUTION 2026-0073**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 24, 2026

### **Approving the Submittal of the Transportation Development Act Claim for Fiscal Year 2025/2026**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Transportation Development Act (TDA) of 1974 allows two percent (2%) of the Local Transportation Fund apportionment to be made available exclusively for pedestrian and bicycle facilities.
- B. In the 2025-2030 Capital Improvement Program Budget Resolution 2025-0162, the City Council authorized use of the TDA funds for maintenance and repair of existing bikeways and development of new bikeways throughout the City of Sacramento.
- C. The Sacramento Area Council of Governments has estimated the amount of TDA funds available to the City of Sacramento for pedestrian and bicycle facilities in Fiscal Year (FY) 2025/26 to be \$606,195.
- D. The Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) requires a claim package be submitted to receive the TDA allocation, including a resolution approved by the City Council authorizing the filing of the claim.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

##### **SECTION 1.**

The TDA claim for reimbursement in the amount of \$606,195 for various bicycle and pedestrian facilities in FY2025/26 is approved.

##### **SECTION 2.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute and submit the TDA claim in the amount of \$606,195 for FY2025/26 to SACOG for approval and reimbursement of the TDA Fund (Fund 2013) and amend any subsequent changes to the allocation for the FY2025/26.

**SECTION 3.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to adjust the FY2025/26 Department of Public Works revenue budget (TDA Fund, Fund 2013) by the reimbursement amount upon receipt of the TDA reimbursement.

**SECTION 4.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to amend the FY2025/26 Department of Public Works revenue budget (TDA Fund, Fund 2013) in the event that the TDA claim amount for FY2025/26 actually received is more or less than the \$606,195 estimate.

**SECTION 5.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to increase the expenditure budget in the Pedestrian and Bike Trail Repair and Maintenance Program (K15222100) by \$2,821 (TDA Fund, Fund 2013) upon receipt of the TDA reimbursement.
