Resolution Designating Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons in

Municipal Off-Street Parking Facilities

SUMMARY

This report recommends the designation of parking spaces for disabled persons in off-street parking facilities.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Parking spaces for disabled persons are provided in all of the City's hourly parking facilities. In order to enforce these regulations under the California Vehicle Code, a resolution designating them accordingly is required.

FINANCIAL DATA

The fine for a vehicle parked in violation of this regulation is \$25 under the California Vehicle Code. If vehicles are cited for the general provisions of the City Code requiring obedience to signs in parking lots, the fine is \$10. All disabled spaces in the City facilities have been signed with a warning that the fine is \$25.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted.

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING PARKING SPACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS IN MUNICIPAL OFF-STREET PARKING FACILITIES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Where designated by signs and marking as described in Section 22507.8 (a) of the California Vehicle Code, parking spaces for disabled persons shall be provided in Municipal Off-Street Parking Facilities. Vehicles parking in such designated parking spaces shall be subject to the provisions of Section 22507.8 of the California Vehicle Code. The designation of said spaces is pursuant to Section 22507.8 (b) of the California Vehicle Code.
