SUMMARY

In order to keep the Council informed concerning police internal investigations into personnel misconduct, beginning in July, 1992, the Chief of Police will provide a quarterly report delineating any recent or on-going investigations and statistics on the number of complaints received and investigated. The quarterly report will be made in executive session in order to preserve the confidentiality of internal investigation information as required by section 832.7 of the Penal Code.

BACKGROUND

In the past, the Chief of Police has provided the Council with information concerning investigations of personnel misconduct upon their request. These reports included summaries of major internal investigations that were either on-going or completed.

In order to keep the Council informed of recent and on-going police department investigations, the Chief of Police will provide them with a quarterly report. The report will include information on major internal investigations which have occurred during the


