
SUMMARY:

SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for Improvements for 11th  
Street Between J Street and J-K Alley

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the subject project have been prepared and approval is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The subject project is part of the Capital Improvement Program of the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency and agreements between the City and the Agency for the installation of the improvements have been executed.

FINANCIAL:

The project is not currently budgeted but the Agency has authorized expenditures for the project up to \$240,000. It is proposed that funding be provided from the Housing and Redevelopment Capital Improvement Fund. A final budgetary recommendation will be made following receipt of bids. The engineer's construction estimate for the project is \$215,275.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend to the full City Council that the plans and specifications be approved and that this project be advertised for bids.
