

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. Bids have been received for the project to repair and redeck the Natomas East Main Drain Canal Bridge at El Camino Avenue and additional funds are needed to award the contract.
2. The Capital Improvement Program is hereby amended by transferring \$27,000 in Major Street Construction Funds from the Overwidth Pavement Reimbursement Program (TF61) to the Major Street Construction Contingency Reserve as follows:

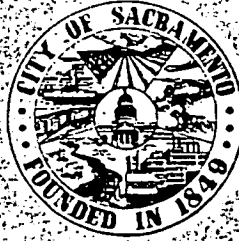

SUBJECT: Natomas East Main Drain Canal Bridge at El Camino Avenue
(PN:TD11) - Appropriation of Funds

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and additional funds are needed to award the contract.

BACKGROUND

This project will provide structural repair and redecking of the existing, deteriorating El Camino Avenue bridge across the East main Drainage Canal. The bridge will be closed for approximately four months during the construction, and traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets and highways.

On January 9, 1990, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for the project. On February 13, 1990, bids were received and opened by the City Clerk. The bids received were:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$356,000. The estimated project completion date is August 15, 1990.

FINANCIAL

Additional funds are needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$427,000. The current budget is \$400,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Major Street Construction Funds (209). The funds currently available for the project amount to \$331,400 as of February 27, 1990. It is proposed that \$27,000 in Major Street Construction Funds (209) be defunded from the Overwidth Pavement Reimbursement Program (PN:TF61) and appropriated to this project. The Overwidth Pavement Program has a current balance of approximately \$661,000 as of February 27, 1990.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

There are no policy considerations associated with this item.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS


Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry in Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. There were thirty-six (36) plan holders for this project, two (2) of whom are certified WBE contractors. One (1) of the WBE plan holders submitted a bid, but was not the low bidder.


