SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on October 14, 1992.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project will provide for the installation of a traffic signal system, street lights, and an interconnect system at the intersection of Norwood Avenue and Jessie Avenue. This project will enhance safety and traffic flow for pedestrians and vehicle traffic at this intersection.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on September 24, 1991. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$112,000.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$170,500. The current budget is \$175,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the Gas Tax fund (202). The funds available for this project amount to \$132,419, as of September 3, 1992.

A non-refundable fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.301 of the City Code concerning advertisement for bids.




