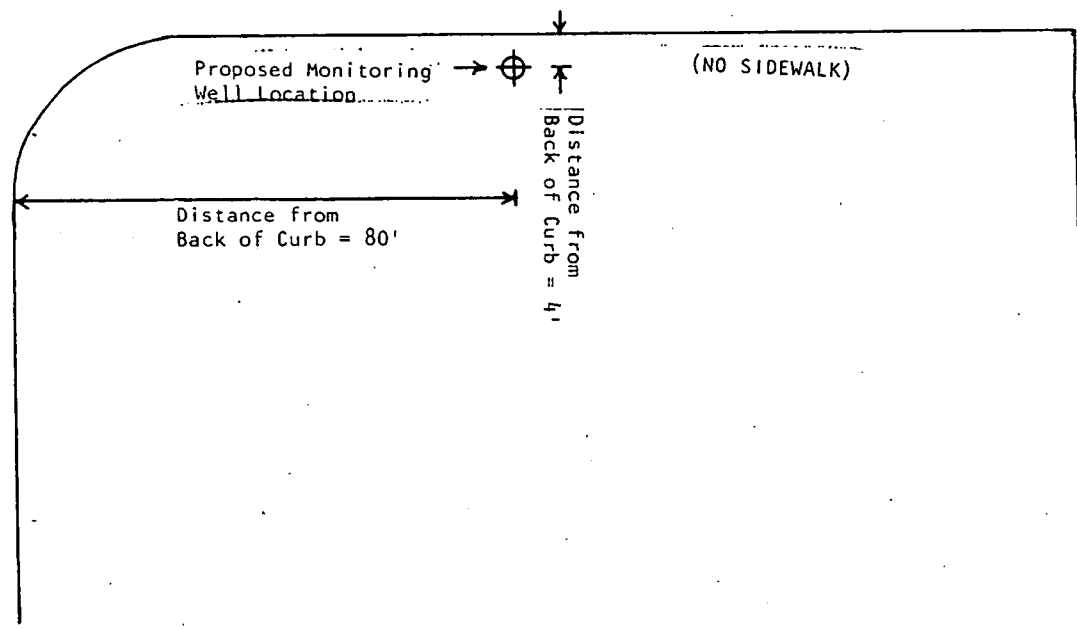
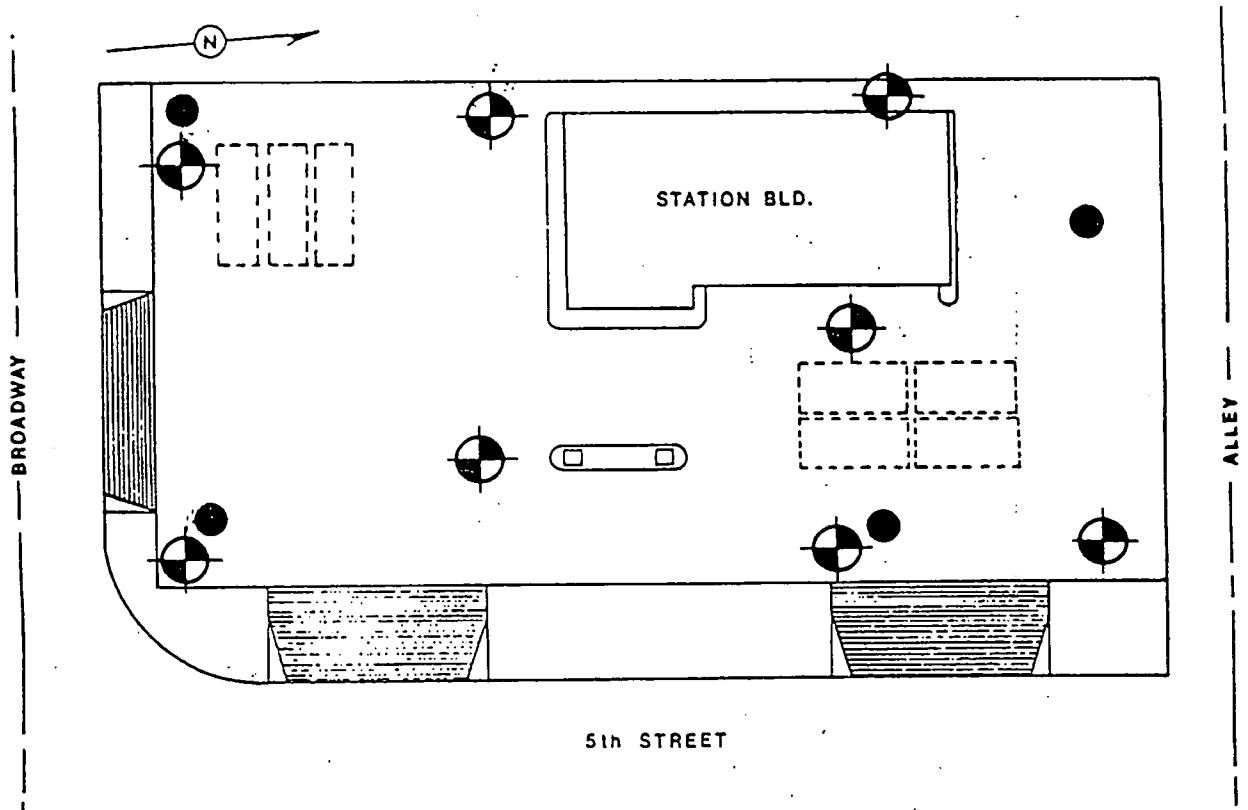
SPECIAL CONDITIONS
