SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for Construction of Play Area and Softball Backstop at Camellia School

SUMMARY:

The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

FINANCIAL DATA:

In F.Y. 1978/79 the City Council approved in the Community Services Budget, \$47,000.00 of Park Development funds and \$19,000.00 of State Grant funds for the subject project. Total amount currently available for this project is \$61,875.00, as of May 23, 1980. The current estimated construction cost is \$63,651.00. Although the estimated cost exceeds the amount budgeted, no budgetary recommendation will be made until receipt of bids.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that the plans and specifications be approved and that bids be received on July 15, 1980.
