AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO
LEVYING A SPECIAL TAX FOR THE
PROPERTY TAX YEAR 1994-95 AND FOLLOWING TAX YEARS

NORTH LAGUNA CREEK COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 93-02

Be it enacted by the Council of the City of Sacramento as follows:

1. Pursuant to Government Code Sections 53328 and 53340, and the Resolution of Formation (No. 93-437, dated July 27, 1993), a special tax is hereby levied on all taxable property within North Laguna Creek Community Facilities District No. 93-02, for the 1994-95 tax year and for each following tax year in the maximum amount per parcel permitted for each such year in accordance with the rate and method of apportionment of special tax as shown in said Resolution of Formation. These amounts may be adjusted annually, subject to the maximum authorized special tax limit, by resolution.
2. The Department of Public Works is directed, with the aid of the appropriate officers and agents of the City, to prepare

each year, and without further action of this Council, the special tax roll and to provide all necessary information to the Sacramento County Auditor and Tax Collector in order to effect the proper billing and collection of the within special tax.

3. The appropriate officers and agents of the City are authorized to make adjustments to the Special Tax Roll prior to the final posting of the special taxes to the county tax rolls each year, as may be necessary to achieve a correct match of special tax levies with the assessor's parcel numbers finally utilized by the County in sending out property tax bills.

4. If for any cause any portion of this ordinance is found to be invalid, or if the special tax is found inapplicable to any particular parcel, by a court of competent jurisdiction, the balance of this ordinance, and the application of the special tax to the remaining parcels, shall not be affected.

5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its date of passage and at least six days shall elapse between the date this ordinance is passed for publication of title and the date it is adopted by the Council. The title of the ordinance shall be published by printing said title in a newspaper
