ORDINANCE NO. 717, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS AND HIRING OF LABOR FOR THE ENLARGEMENT OF THE DINING ROOM AND KITCHEN IN THE CLUB HOUSE ON THE SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. It is hereby directed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that the City Manager purchase the necessary materials and hire the necessary labor for the enlargement of the dining room and kitchen in the Club House on the Sacramento Municipal Golf Course at an estimated cost of \$3,500.00, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency being as follows: It is necessary to have said improvements completed before the National Golf Tournament to be held in January, 1937.
