CITY CLERK**RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING DAIN J. DOMICH, SR.**

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of Sacramento suffered a great loss in the passing of Dain J. Domich, Sr. on the 20th day of May, 1989 at the age of 71; and

WHEREAS, Dain served with distinction as a member of the City Council from 1960 until 1967; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure in office several landmark decisions were made, two of which were the annexation of North Sacramento and elevation of the 29-30th Streets Freeway; and

WHEREAS, Dain's reputation as a public servant, who would readily take to heart the problems of any and all his constituents, grew immeasurably from a personal, innate love of the city of his birth -- a city whose reputation he guarded jealously; and

WHEREAS, that reputation was precipitated by and borne out when, in 1950, he was honored as Sacramento's outstanding Young Man of the Year and, in 1953, one of five of California's outstanding young men; and

WHEREAS, as national President of the Junior Chamber of Commerce, he traveled to the capital cities of our 50 states and 28 foreign countries in honor of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, his commitment to public need continued unstintingly over the years as President of the Easter Seal Society and Director of the American Red Cross, American Heart Association and Sacramento Symphony; and

WHEREAS, a city is known by its people, it is fitting and proper that it be recorded that Sacramento has lost one of her favorite sons;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Dain J. Domich, Sr.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be tendered to his bereaved family as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
