SUBJECT: 3rd Street Sewer, 1st to 2nd Avenues (PN:XA76) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will abandon an existing deteriorated sewer line which is located in an abandoned street beneath existing structures and cannot be adequately maintained. A new sewer line in 3rd Street will provide for the existing service connections. A Categorical Exemption for the project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on July 9, 1986.

On July 15, 1986 the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on August 5, 1986. The bids received were:

A-Seven-H General Construction	\$ 34,516
Jerry Gavrilko Company	\$ 38,950
William Morris Construction Company	\$ 39,844
D.C.M. Construction	\$ 48,825

The engineer's estimated contract cost was \$28,500. The estimated project completion date is November 14, 1986. Even though the low bid of A-Seven-H General Construction was 21% above the engineer's estimate, it is believed to be the best bid available at this time.

FINANCIAL


Additional funds are needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$47,500. The current budget is \$35,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Sewer Funds. An additional \$12,500 will be transferred from the Miscellaneous Sewer Improvements Account, which has sufficient approved and appropriated funds to allow the transfer.


It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of A-Seven-H General Construction in the amount of \$34,516 and award the contract.


