

**RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT PERMIT TO
GROUNDWATER TECHNOLOGY, INC.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a Revocable Encroachment Permit be granted for the purpose of installing and maintaining two (2) monitoring wells to test for underground pollutants whose address is Groundwater Technology, Inc., 1401 Halyard Drive, Suite 140, West Sacramento, California, 95691.

This encroachment is described as follows:

Well No. 1 is to be placed at the northeast corner of El Camino and Taft Street. Well No. 2 is 210 feet north of the centerline of El Camino Avenue on the east side of Taft Street.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management and Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

This permit is valid for a maximum of five years. The owner is responsible for proper abandonment of the wells in accordance with City and County Public Health requirements prior to the five year expiration date. Work shall not begin until an encroachment/excavation permit has been obtained from the City.

On August 22, 1989, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 89-644 granting the following Revocable Encroachment Permit. This is in accordance with "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit," adopted by City Council Resolution No. 81-845 as amended.

The permit is for the purpose of installing and maintaining two monitoring wells located at 1251 El Camino Avenue, at the northeast corner of El Camino and Taft Street, and 210 feet north of the centerline of El Camino Avenue on the east side of Taft Street.

This permit shall be effective only after you file the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions. These can be filed with the Risk Management Division at 915 "I" Street, Room 14, Sacramento, California 95814.
