**SUMMARY**

This report requests adoption of the attached resolution which declares the official result of the April 10, 2001 Special Municipal Election, as certified by the County Registrar of Voters.

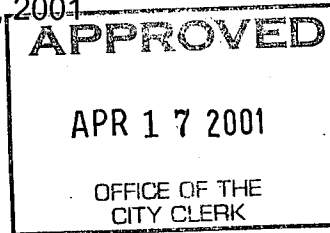
**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

On Tuesday, April 10, 2001, the City of Sacramento held a Special Municipal Election for the purposes of electing a Councilmember to fill a vacancy in the office of Council District 1.

On December 5, 2000, the City council adopted Resolution 2000-703, authorizing the County Registrar of Voters to render certain election services to the City of Sacramento in connection with the conducting of an April 10, 2001 Special Municipal Election, pursuant to Section 10002 of the Elections Code. The results of the election have been certified by the County, and are contained in the attached Certificates of Fact. Pursuant to the results contained in the Certificates of Fact, the number and percentage of votes received by Ray Tretheway, for the office of Council District 1, is sufficient to declare him elected.

There are no policy considerations associated with this item.

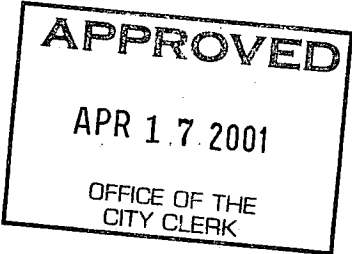

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACTS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON APRIL 10, 2001, DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held on Tuesday, April 10, 2001, for the election of a District One Municipal Officer in the City of Sacramento, California, as required by the provisions of the laws of the State of California relating to Charter cities; and

WHEREAS, that notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2000-703, adopted on December 5, 2000, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the number of votes cast, including absentee ballots, in the Council District One race was 4,725.

SECTION 2. That the names of persons voted for at the election and the results of the votes cast are as follows:

The City Council does declare and determine that Ray Tretheway was elected as Councilmember, City Council District 1.

SECTION 3. That the official results of the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the office of Councilmember, Council District 1, received from the County Office of Voter Registration and Election, will be entered into the official records of the City of Sacramento.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) the whole number of votes cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons voted for; (3) for what office each person voted; (4) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person; and, (5) the total number of votes given to each person.

SECTION 5. That the City Clerk shall, pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10265, make and deliver to the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk did also administer to the person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. The person so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which she has been elected.

SECTION 6: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
