SUBJECT: Emergency Ordinance Regulating the Speed Limit and River Closures for the Sacramento Water Festival, July 2nd, July 3rd, and 4th, 1988

SUMMARY

Special regulations are necessary to support the river activities scheduled for the Sacramento Water Festival, July 2nd, July 3rd, and 4th, 1988. This report recommends adoption of an emergency ordinance regulating the speed and effecting closures of portions of the Sacramento River during the Water Festival.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION


The City Council has endorsed and supports the scheduling of a fifth annual celebration of the rivers of Sacramento in early July. This activity will be presented in the form of the Sacramento Water Festival and will feature numerous water activities including water-skiing, jet skis, ski sailing, kayaks, sport parachuting and the formula motor boat races.

It is necessary to approve special regulations for the control of those portions of the Sacramento River that will be utilized for Festival activities in order to assure the safety of the general public. The City of West Sacramento and Counties of Sacramento and Yolo are being requested to adopt identical measures. The respective Sheriff's of the County of Yolo and Sacramento and the Police Chief of the City of West Sacramento are given concurrent jurisdiction and authority with the Chief of Police to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.


RECOMMENDATION

ORDINANCE NO. 88-041

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED LIMIT ON AND CLOSING PART OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER TO BOATS AND PERSONS NOT PARTICIPATING IN THE SACRAMENTO WATER FESTIVAL COMPETITION JULY 2, 3, & 4, 1988 AND DECLARING SAID ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS: JUN 8 1988

SECTION 1

OFFICE OF THE
CITY CLERK

From and after 8:30 a.m., July 2, 1988, through and including 5:00 p.m. July 4, 1988, between two hundred feet upstream of the north wing dam of the Tower Bridge to 200 feet downstream of the south wing dam of the Pioneer Bridge (Interstate 80), the speed limit on the Sacramento River for all boats not specifically exempted from this ordinance shall be five (5) miles per hour. The term "five miles per hour" in the preceding sentence shall mean five miles per hour relative to the stream bottom for upstream speeds and relative to water surface for downstream speeds. There are specifically exempted from speed limits boats participating in the formula motor boat competition, boats directly officially participating in the Sacramento Water Festival, and boats officially conducting public safety functions.

SECTION 2

During the dates and times set forth below, the Sacramento River between two hundred feet upstream of the north wing dam of the Tower Bridge to 200 feet downstream of the south wing dam of the Pioneer Bridge (Interstate 80), shall be closed to all boat traffic and persons not specifically exempted from this ordinance whether in the water without any equipment or device, or using any equipment device whatsoever. There are only specifically exempted from this Section 2 boats participating in the Sacramento Water Festival Competition, and boats officially conducting public safety functions, and persons on board such boats. The dates and times during which this Section 2 are effective shall be:

SECTION 3

Any persons who shall violate the foregoing Sections 1 or 2 shall be guilty of an infraction and subject to a fine not to exceed \$100.00.

SECTION 4

The Sheriffs of the Counties of Sacramento & Yolo and the Police Chief of the City of West Sacramento are given concurrent jurisdiction and authority with the Chief of Police to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance to take effect immediately. The grounds for the emergency is the schedule of the event is less than thirty (30) days from the date of consideration by the City Council.

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED LIMIT ON AND CLOSING PART OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER TO BOATS AND PERSONS NOT PARTICIPATING IN THE SACRAMENTO WATER FESTIVAL COMPETITION JULY 2, 3, & 4, 1988

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

From and after 8:30 a.m., July 2, 1988, through and including 5:00 p.m. July 4, 1988, between two hundred feet upstream of the north wing dam of the Tower Bridge to 200 feet downstream of the south wing dam of the Pioneer Bridge (Interstate 80), the speed limit on the Sacramento River for all boats not specifically exempted from this ordinance shall be five (5) miles per hour. The term "five miles per hour" in the preceding sentence shall mean five miles per hour relative to the stream bottom for upstream speeds and relative to water surface for downstream speeds.
