**SUBJECT:** Improvement Proceeding No. 5301, Construction of Sidewalk  
on 2nd Avenue West of 43rd Street

SUMMARY:

Adoption of a Resolution by the City Council initiating proceedings to construct a sidewalk on 2nd Avenue between Santa Clara Way and 43rd Street.

BACKGROUND:

The City Engineer has received complaints that there is no sidewalk in front of the property at 4224 2nd Avenue. It is the finding of the Superintendent of Streets that sidewalks have been constructed in front of all properties on the above mentioned street except at 4224 2nd Avenue. Thus, sidewalks have been constructed for more than 50% of the front footage.

Therefore, authorization from the City Council is requested to commence proceedings for the construction of sidewalk at 4224 2nd Avenue where no sidewalk exists, pursuant to Division 7, Chapter 27 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California by adoption of the attached Resolution for Improvement Proceeding No. 5301. This Resolution authorizes the Superintendent of Streets to notify the property owner to construct sidewalks within 60 days of the adoption of this Resolution and at the end of said 60 days, if the sidewalk is not constructed by the owner, the City will construct said sidewalk and place a lien on the property for the cost.

A meeting was held with the property owner on January 21st, 1983 to ascertain her desire concerning the method of sidewalk construction. She stated that she would prefer to have the City do the work and place a lien on the property. This would enable her to have the payment become part of her 1983-84 tax bill.

FINANCIAL:

If the property owner refuses to construct the sidewalk in the required 60 days, it is estimated that it will cost the City \$600.00 to do the work. Said \$600.00 will be recovered by the City at a later date through a billing process or as a lien on the property and collected with the taxes for the 1983-84 fiscal year.

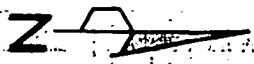

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS TO NOTIFY PROPERTY OWNER TO CONSTRUCT SIDEWALK ON PORTION OF 2ND AVENUE BETWEEN SANTA CLARA WAY AND 43RD STREET AND FIXING THE DATE, HOW AND PLACE FOR HEARING OBJECTIONS THERETO

RESOLVED that pursuant to Division 7, Chapter 27 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, the Superintendent of Streets is hereby directed to notify the property owner of 4224 2nd Avenue to construct a sidewalk on the south side of 2nd Avenue between Santa Clara Way and 43rd Street; as required by the City of Sacramento Standard Specifications; and as shown on the plans attached hereto and made a part hereof, in said block where over 50% of the sidewalks have heretofore been constructed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., on the 22nd day of February, 1983, in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, on I Street, between 9th and 10th Streets in said City, is hereby fixed as the day, place and time for hearing of objections or protests, if any, and show cause why the proposed work and improvements shall not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution.
