SUMMARY:

On July 29, 2003 the City Council approved an ordinance imposing a temporary moratorium on the issuance of new taxicab vehicle permits until December 31, 2004. The proposed ordinance will extend the moratorium until December 31, 2005 to allow for implementation of taxi regulatory reforms.

BACKGROUND

Prior to publication of an item in a local paper to meet legal advertising requirements, the City Council must first pass the item for publication. The City Clerk then transmits the title of the item to the paper of publication and for advertising the meeting.

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING A TEMPORARY PROHIBITION ON ISSUANCE OF TAXICAB VEHICULAR PERMITS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

This interim ordinance is enacted to address the following facts and circumstances:

A. On July 29, 2003, the City Council enacted Ordinance No. 2003-036 suspending issuance of new taxicab vehicular permits through December 31, 2004.

B. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2003-036 provides that the suspension may be extended by action of the City Council.

C. The City Council's review of the City's taxicab regulatory scheme is underway but involves numerous complex policy issues. Resolving these issues and implementing appropriate changes will require a number of months. The City Council desire to extend the period during which issuance of new taxicab vehicular permits is suspended through December 31, 2005.

SECTION 2.

The effective period of Ordinance No. 2003-036 is hereby extended to and through December 31, 2005, and shall thereafter expire unless extended by further action of the Council.
