SUBJECT: Conflict of Interest Code

SUMMARY

The attached resolution amends the Conflict of Interest Code for the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento and the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento effective for the period beginning January 1, 1987.

BACKGROUND

A Conflict of Interest Code must be amended in the event of changed circumstances, such as the addition of new positions (Government Code Section 87306). Since the last amendment to the Code in January, 1984, a number of new decision-making classifications have been added to the Agency's Classification Plan. These are Administrative Service Officer, Assistant Director of Community Development, Assistant Director of Housing, Chief of Evaluation and Legislative Analysis, Chief of Neighborhood Development, Director of Special Projects, Program Manager (CDBG), Program Manager (Housing Finance), Program Manager (Housing Rehabilitation), Program Manager (Housing Services), Program Manager (Technical Services), Program Manager (Accounting System), Assistance Chief of Maintenance, and Technical Supervisor. The staff is recommending that the above listed job classifications be added to the designated classifications in the Conflict of Interest Code. In addition, all job classifications that have been eliminated by the Agency would be removed from the Classification Plan.

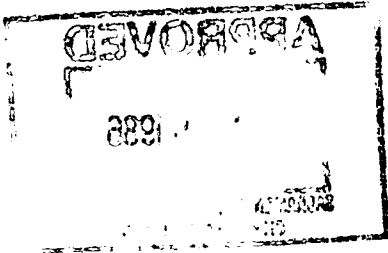

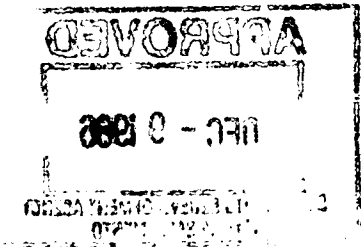

APPENDIX

Persons holding the following positions shall make investment and real property disclosures, personal income disclosure, business entity income disclosures, and business position disclosures, as required and in a manner prescribed by this Code for the type of real property, businesses, as described in the applicable disclosure categories.

- B.
