


This item was heard before the Budget and Finance Committee on September 11, 1990. The Committee agreed to forward this request to the City Council for consideration with a recommendation for approval.

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 89-388 AUTHORIZING  
THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE  
NORTH SACRAMENTO SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE  
SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

- 1) The City Manager, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, an amendment to City Agreement No. 88236 with the North Sacramento School District to reduce the number of School Crossing Guards from two Crossing Guards to one Crossing Guard.
- 2) The City Manager, or his designated representative, is further authorized to execute, on behalf of the City Council, any extensions or additional amendments.
- 3) The Office of Operations (org. #2165) be increased .44 FTE for one School Crossing Guard.
- 4) The General Fund Revenue Budget for fiscal year 90/91 is amended to include an additional \$10,175 from the North Sacramento School District (101-210-2165-3XXX).
- 5) The General Fund Administrative Contingency is increased by \$10,175 due to the revenue from the North Sacramento School District (101-710-7012-4999).
- 6) The General Fund Administrative Contingency (101-710-7012-4999) is reduced to transfer \$10,175 to the Police Department Traffic Section (101-210-2165-4XXX) to provide one School Crossing Guard in the North Sacramento School District.

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS TO THE NORTH  
SACRAMENTO SCHOOL DISTRICT

SUMMARY

This report requests a replacement of Resolution No. 89-388 which authorizes an agreement between the Police Department and the North Sacramento School District to provide School Crossing Guards in the school district. The new resolution would reduce the number of School Crossing Guards per the request of the school district and authorize the City Manager to execute any further extensions or amendments.

BACKGROUND

On May 16, 1989, City Council approved and adopted Resolution No. 89-388 authorizing an agreement with the North Sacramento School District to provide two (2) School Crossings Guards in the school district. The North Sacramento School District agreed to reimburse the City for all costs involved in the hiring, training, and supervising the crossing guards. The adopted resolution authorized an increase of .18 FTE in School Crossing Guards for the remainder of the 88/89 fiscal year. Due to the request by the North Sacramento School District to reduce the number of Crossing Guards in the agreement from two to one, Resolution No. 89-388 was never implemented.

The Police Department is now requesting that a new resolution be adopted to replace Resolution No. 89-388. The new resolution will authorize one additional Crossing Guard position for the Police Department and increase the General Fund Revenue Budget by the amount to be reimbursed by the North Sacramento School District. All other provisions of the agreement will remain the same.

Budget and Finance Committee  
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FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost for one School Crossing Guard, administrative costs, and equipment for the 90/91 fiscal year is \$10,175. Under the terms of the agreement this cost will be reimbursed by the North Sacramento School District.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

Approval of this amendment to the agreement is consistent with past practices.


