SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City enter into an agreement with the Zoological Society, a non-profit organization applying for grant funds to improve a City facility.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento Zoological Society is the non-profit support organization of the Zoo Division of the Department of Parks and Community Services. The Society wishes to apply for grant funds, as appropriated by the California Park and Recreation Act of 1984, to construct an outdoor Interpretive Center for animal shows and demonstrations.

This outdoor amphitheater will seat up to 200 zoo visitors in a naturalistic setting on the zoo grounds. The stage and the seating areas will be shaded by both adjacent trees and nylon shading material supported on cables suspended from poles. Behind the stage will be a single climate controlled room that will house animals used in the zoo's shows and demonstrations. This facility will be fully accessible to the handicapped and will have ample space for wheelchairs.

This agreement will allow the Society to build this facility on the zoo grounds and use it for approved educational and recreation activities. The city's Zoo Division will maintain this facility and the city assume title to facility and all its' equipment.

FINANCIAL DATA

The cost estimate for the project is approximately \$150,000. The entire cost will be applied for in the grant, and the City will not be required to commit funds to this project.


