SUBJECT: FEE FOR SAFE DRINKING WATER DEVELOPMENT PLAN

SUMMARY

A mandated, one-time fee on public water systems which serve more than 500 connections has been levied by the State Department of Health Services for the exclusive purpose of covering its costs in preparing the Safe Drinking Water Plan. It is requested that the City's fee of \$10,000, be transferred from Water Fund Contingency to the Water Division's operating budget.

In its meeting of September 11, 1990, the Budget and Finance committee requested that the resolution include an expression of protest to the practice of assessing the costs of State programs to local governments without reimbursement and local control over the implementation of the program.



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SUMMARY

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BACKGROUND

Assembly Bill 21 (Sher), which was approved by the Governor last September, among other things, added a section to the Health and Safety Code which would require the Department of Health Services to develop a comprehensive Safe Drinking Water Plan for California. A subsection of this addition establishes a one time fee on public water systems to cover the Department's costs in preparing the plan.

The fee is set at a rate of \$0.0915 per service connection up to a maximum of \$10,000. Since the City presently has 110,000 customers, our fee will be \$10,000.

At the time of City budget preparation, it was decided that since the State had not yet decided to levy the fee that it not be included in the Water Division's submitted budget.

FINANCIAL

The source of the \$10,000 fee would be the Water Contingency Fund (413-710-7012-4999) which has a current balance of \$6,374,000 as indicated in the proposed 1990-91 Budget.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

Payment of the \$10,000 fee is required by State law as a result of the passage of AB 21.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee approve the transfer of \$10,000 from the Water Contingency Fund to the Water Division's operating budget and forward this report to the full City Council for approval of the attached resolution.



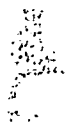
- 2. The Council protests and objects to the practices as exemplified by AB 21, of assessing local governments for the costs of State programs without reimbursement and local control over the implementation.
