**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Franklin Boulevard and Armadale Way - Council District 7.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the plans and specifications;
- Accept the bid of M&M Electric in the amount of \$88,888; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the Franklin Boulevard and Armadale Way Traffic Signal project.

**SUMMARY:**

This project will install a new traffic signal at the intersection of Franklin Boulevard and Armadale Way. In addition, this project will include pedestrian facilities and handicap ramps. The project promotes City Council priorities regarding neighborhood revitalization, enhancement and public safety.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- This project was authorized in the 1993/94 Capital Improvement Program.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on November 8, 1995 and are summarized below:

- The construction estimate is \$105,000.
- M&M Electric has performed an acceptable good faith effort.
- Approval of the plans and specifications and award to M&M Electric is recommended.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

- The project budget for Franklin Boulevard and Armadale Way Traffic Signal is \$200,000.
- The unobligated fund balance as of November 1, 1995 is \$177,080 which is sufficient for award.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has determined that this project is exempt from CEQA per State Class 1 and 2 and Section Number 15301(c) and 15303(c).

A notice of categorical exemption was filed for this project on October 5, 1995.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


