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1. Request to Open Application Period

- A. STOCKTON BOULEVARD REDEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE to fill four (4) positions under the following categories: residential owner occupant, residential tenants and business owner. This opening represents three (3) seats where appointees resigned prior to term expirations in February 2006 and one (1) seat with term expiration in February 2005. Appointees shall be nominated by city council districts 5 & 6 in coordination with the Board of Supervisors districts 1 & 2 , appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. (Districts 5 & 6).

APPOINTMENT: Twelve (12) members nominated by Districts 5 and 6 (in coordination with Board of Supervisors Districts 1 and 2), appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, and jointly appointed by the County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Three (3) members from each of the following categories:

- A. Residential Owner Occupants
- B. Residential Tenants
- C. Business Owners (includes non-resident property owners)
- D. Community Based Organizations (within the redevelopment area)

The committee may include a high school student residing within the redevelopment project area as a youth representative in any one of the four specified categories.

TERM: Two (2) year term. Two term limit applies.

MEETING INFO: Monthly.

COMPENSATION: \$20.00 per meeting attended.

POWERS & DUTIES: The powers and duties of this board include:

Serves in an advisory capacity to the Redevelopment Agency in matters relating to social, economic and physical concerns in the Stockton Boulevard area.

1. Provide advice on policy matters dealing with the planning and promotion of residential facilities and other matters affecting residents of the project area.
2. Review and comment on proposed redevelopment activities and assist in formulation of projects and programs to meet identified goals and objectives.
