**RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING PHILLIP L. BURTON**

**IT IS HEREBY NOTED** that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Congressman Phillip L. Burton on the tenth day of April, 1983, at the age of fifty-six, in San Francisco, California.

**WHEREAS**, Phillip L. Burton represented San Francisco's District 5 in the United States Congress from 1964 to 1983, and before that, he served in the California State Assembly for seven years; and,

**WHEREAS**, he officially represented one district in San Francisco, but Congressman Burton's actions affected people all over this State and Nation, as he championed environmental causes, adding millions of acres to the National parks and wilderness areas, as he fought for and won important labor and human rights laws involving workers' health and safety, minimum wage and Supplemental Security Income, and as he followed his conscience in speaking out against America's policies in Indochina during the 1960's; and,

**WHEREAS**, the influence that Phillip L. Burton exerted over State and National affairs for the past 25 years cannot be overestimated--we owe him a debt of gratitude for his constant commitment to the public good and he will long be remembered by many Californians with affection and respect; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Phillip L. Burton, and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Phillip L. Burton;

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to Sala Burton, bereaved wife and closest adviser, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
