

ORDINANCE NO. 690, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE IN OPEN MARKET A CARLOAD OF SULPHURIC ACID IMMEDIATELY, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market for and on behalf of the City a carload lot of sulphuric acid, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency being the necessity of immediately procuring said carload of sulphuric acid since not a sufficient supply is on hand to permit the time necessary to advertise.
