

## **RESOLUTION 2026-0070**

### **Authorizing the City Manager to Establish Revenue and Expense Budgets for Funding from the California Natural Resources Agency for North Natomas Regional Park Phase 7 Improvements**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The State of California awarded \$500,000 to the City of Sacramento in grant funds for North Natomas Regional Park through Senate Bill (SB) 105 Section 0540-103-0001 (Amendment to Budget Act of 2025) which makes appropriations for the support of local government projects and programs. This allocation was made at the request of Senator Angelique Ashby.
- B. The primary purpose of this funding is for improvements at North Natomas Regional Park, which will include clearing and grubbing, fine grading, irrigation, landscaping, concrete paving, decomposed granite paving, group picnic areas, site furnishings and hydroseeding.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

#### **SECTION 1.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to establish revenue and expenditure budgets in the Citywide Park Improvement Project (L19300000), Fund 3704 in the amount of \$500,000.
