to the recently adopted policy affecting employees who work on "on call", was considered and Mr. Hicks moved that said hearing be held October 5, 1950 at 7:30 P.M.; seconded by Mr. Deise and motion carried.

METER SERVICEMAN EX. #272

Verbal request from the Superintendent
of the Water Department with reference
to Meter Serviceman Examination No. 272

and requesting that Servicemen now employed in the Water Department be permitted to take said examination on a promotional basis, was considered.

After general discussion by members of the Board and after determining that the salary range for Serviceman was the same as the salary range established for Meter Serviceman, Mr. Hicks moved that foregoing request be denied; seconded by Mr. Deise and motion carried.

The Secretary reported that an eligible on Uniform Fireman Eligible Register No. 208 who was certified for appointment to a permanent position was now in military service.

After general discussion of policy by members of the Board, Mr. Hicks moved that the Secretary prepare written rules governing certification of eligibles during the present emergency, for consideration at the next regular meeting of the Board; seconded by Mr. Deise and motion carried.

Mr. Deise thereupon moved that the Secretary be instructed to continue certifications from eligible registers under the present rules, pending adoption of new rules; seconded by Mr. Hicks and motion carried.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned to meet again at the call of the Chair.
