### SUMMARY

Attached for approval is Program Supplement No. 33, to Local Agency-State Agreement No. 03-5002 covering Federal Aid Urban Project No. M-MG-F034(4), Howe Avenue/LaRiviera Drive Access Ramps and Traffic Signal Project.

### BACKGROUND

On July 5, 1977, the City of Sacramento entered into Agreement No. 03-5002 with the State of California, Department of Transportation, under which the City and State agreed upon procedures for expenditures of Federal Aid Urban Funds (FAU) administered by the State. Subsequent program supplemental agreements are required for certain phases of each project under this program. Program Supplement No. 33 covers the Howe Ave./LaRiviera Drive Access Ramps and Traffic Signal project. The project is currently being designed and construction is anticipated later this year.

### FINANCIAL

As indicated on Exhibit B of the agreement, the preliminary engineering, construction, and construction engineering is estimated to cost \$400,000 of which the City's estimated share is \$34,500. Major Street Construction funds were budgeted in 1984-85 to cover the City's share of the project cost (C.C. 9618).


The Director of Public Works recommends that the attached resolution be approved authorizing the City Manager and the City Clerk to execute Program Supplement No. 33.


