

ORDINANCE NO. 741, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 304, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED NOVEMBER 12, 1926, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAVEL, TRAFFIC AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES LAID OUT FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, DEFINING THE TERMS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE, CREATING CERTAIN TRAFFIC DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 80, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 22ND, 1922, AND ALL ORDINANCES AMENDATORY THEREOF." BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE NUMBERED 32 $\frac{1}{2}$.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 304, Fourth Series, passed November 12 1926, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered 32 $\frac{1}{2}$.

SECTION 32 $\frac{1}{2}$. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 32 hereof, parking shall be permitted for a period of sixty minutes between the hours of 8 o'clock A.M. and 6 o'clock P.M. in parking spaces which are controlled by parking meters;


Provided, however, that the City Manager may, in congested traffic areas, vary the parking time limits in this section specified;

Provided, further, that said time limits shall not apply, nor the depositing of a coin be required, on the following designated holidays - every Sunday, New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Admission Day, Armistice Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
