SUMMARY

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND

On July 21, 1981 the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Street Light Conversion Program Phase II and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on August 11, 1981. Bids received are as follows:

In the letter to Council on July 21, 1981 it was stated that the City would accept bids for Item 1 or for Item 2 or for Item 3, whichever best serves the City's interest.

FINANCIAL DATA


In FY 1979-1980 the City Council approved in the Engineering Budget \$390,680 of Revenue Sharing Funds for the subject project. Total amount currently available for this project is \$151,816. Total construction cost for the 3 items is \$126,415.

Total estimated construction cost for Item 1. was \$77,000; for Item 2. \$50,000 and for Item 3. \$15,000 for a total estimated construction cost of \$142,000.


RECOMMENDATION

The City Engineer recommends that the low bid of M & M Electric in the amount of \$72,461 for Item 1. be accepted for that portion of the project. The City Engineer recommends that the low bid of Elk Grove Electric in the amount of \$46,570 for Item 2. be accepted and the low bid of Elk Grove Electric in the amount of \$7,384 for Item 3. be accepted.
