SUMMARY

This report provides information regarding the extension of terms for four (4) members of the Department of Parks and Community Services' Citizens Advisory Committee. This report is for information only.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Department of Parks and Community Services' Citizens Advisory Committee was created in 1986 to provide a link between citizens and the Department and is a primary means for making certain that services are geared to the needs of the public. Representation on the Committee is based on the eleven city planning areas and three members serve at large.

Over the past two years, a major focus of the Committee has been the update of the 1984 Master Plan for Park Facilities and Recreation Services. The Committee held numerous community meetings and worked with Department management and staff to build priorities for the next five years.

The process of the Master Plan Update is currently nearing completion. The Department anticipates a final document will be published in August 1989. Currently four members of the Committee who have served on the Committee since its inception, and who have been very active in the update of the Master Plan are filling terms which expired in May 1989. They are Karolyn Simon, Chairperson, William Gill, Vice-chairperson, Donna Pozzi and Susan Z'berg.

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It is the desire of the Department and these Committee members that their terms be extended through the completion of the Master Plan Update. This would extend their appointment through August 1989.

The Department has actively been recruiting replacements for these members as well as for several other vacancies and will continue to do so through June. Applicants have been notified that terms will begin in September rather than in June. Recruitment is coordinated through the City Clerk's office.

FINANCIAL DATE

Citizen's Advisory Committee members are not paid for their participation and any incidental expenses are funded through existing Department budgets.




